- -it will be
 - \$300 for 1-5 sessions
 - \$250 for 6-10 sessions
 - \$200 for 11-15 sessions

-Westboro will need 16 sessions and that will be \$200 each for a total of \$3200

- work with K- 3 for 1-1.5 hours

- work with 4-6 for 1.5-2 hours

- looking into doing a gratitude journals

-this will tie in with the resiliency and the goals of Westboro

-it is not a "one-off" - it will have a long lasting effect and can be built on throughout the year and repeated
