Trustee Report – Don Irwin

- Additional information:
  - The board has been busy in August with school start up discussions and then bringing revisions later in August and early September as the fourth wave of Covid has affected schools and the community.
  - We felt it wise to institute a full masking program on an interim basis until the number of cases turns around. This decision will be reviewed on a monthly basis.
  - School sports and field trips are proceeding as normal and all other school activities are fully functioning.
  - Municipal elections for Mayor Council and School board trustees will take place on October 18 and more information will be coming about advanced polls and voting locations.
  - September 30 has been declared as a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation with Aboriginal peoples and will be a school holiday.
  - $\circ$  We have added \$200,000 to the homeschool budget for this year.

## Administration Report – Tracey Prouse
