VIRTUAL CHRISTMAS CONCERT

We've been busy filming to prepare for our upcoming virtual concert. We will be wrapping up our filming in the upcoming week. It was brought up at our Council meeting tonight that it would be helpful for these schedules to be shared. This is our first year going virtual and we're learning as we go; my apologies this was not provided earlier.

Please see below as to when classes will be filmed.

- **Monday, November 29:** KL (wear jammies), PLACE 2 (no special dress required), 4L and 4R (Christmas fancy wear if desired)
- Tuesday, November 30: KR (wear jammies), 3L and 3R (no special dress required)
- **Wednesday, December 1**: 3L and 3R (Christmas fancy wear if desired), 4L and 4R (no special dress required)
- **Thursday, December 2**: 5L and 5R (Christmas fancy wear if desired), 1L and 1R (Christmas fancy wear if desired), possibly 4L and 4R (no special dress required)
- **Friday, December 3**: 1L and 1R (wear dark colours NO white, working with black light), 2L and 2R (Christmas colours and clothing they can move in, fun and funky if desired), 6L (wear all black)

NOTE: 6R is not listed. They have been filming since October. 6L has also already filmed and were given advance notice of their filming times. STEPS and PLACE 1 filming schedule will be as suited to classroom activities.

RETURNING STUDENT REGISTRATION FOR 2022-23

Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) will once again conduct an online returning student registration process to confirm student registrations for the 2022-23 school year. Families of all current students—with the exception of graduating Grade 12 students—must complete the process to confirm the school their child plans to attend in the 2022-23 school year or advise the Division of their plans not to return to EIPS. Additionally, students who want to attend a non-designated school need to make that request through the returning student registration process—acceptance is based on available space. The 2022-23 returning student registration takes place Feb. 1-28, 2022.

Access to the Returning Student Registration Form is provided through the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>. If you don't have a PowerSchool Parent Portal account, you need to set one up before Feb. 1, 2022.

FEE WAIVER DEADLINE

If circumstances exist where you're unable to pay school or transportation fees, you can apply to have fees waived by submitting an Application for a Waiver of Fees. The application deadline is Dec. 15, 2021. If you're new to the Division, the deadline is the latter of Dec. 15, 2021, or 45 days after registration.

To access your fee information, simply log in to the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> and go to "Student Fees." There you can view your fees and pay them online using Visa or MasterCard. All fees are due within 30 days of being posted.

Don't forget to also log in to the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> regularly throughout the year. Fees are often added to your child's account to cover the cost of various school activities such as field trips, class projects, extracurricular activities and more.

LEARNING DISRUPTION FUNDING FOR GRADES 2-3

At the end of last school year, the Government of Alberta announced 2021–22 funding for school divisions to help address learning disruptions for grades 1 to 3 students caused by the pandemic. Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) has received \$791,840 in learning disruption funding to support students in grades 2 and 3, a portion of which has been allocated to Westboro Elementary.

The funding will provide targeted programming for specific students identified as requiring additional support in literacy and numeracy. At Westboro Elementary, all grades 2 and 3 students participated in the Star Reading assessment and the Numeracy Assessment Screener earlier this year to assess students' literacy and numeracy levels. Those below the 25th percentile were identified as needing additional supports and eligible for funding. The Government of Alberta learning disruption funding received—at a per-student funding rate of \$490—will support targeted intervention programming for these students.

If your child was identified as needing additional supports, you'll receive more information directly from the school. Intervention programming for identified students will begin in January. If you have questions about the intervention programming, contact the school office at 780–467–7751.

- 3. There will be a 'no return' policy on all items purchased with a **Fundraising Code** because the School/Organization will receive the 15% rebate.
- 4. The Fundraising Code will not be valid on our website after midnight Dec. 7, 2021.
- 5. Depending on the response of Schools/Organizations to this opportunity, items may sell out and be removed from the list or replaced with a new item as stock allows. Education Station will adjust items at their discretion and if an item is ordered that is out of stock they will contact you directly to see if you would like a substitution or removed from your order.

COVID-19 UPDATE

NEW! All Albertans 5+ can now get vaccinated. As of November 15, proof of completed vaccination series with personal QR code is the only accepted vaccination proof for all non-essential services. Negative test or medical exemptions are accepted. Private outdoor gatherings are limited to 20 people and 2m distancing. Masks and physical distancing are mandatory province-wide in all indoor public spaces, workplaces and public vehicles. View the current Strathcona County COVID-19 case count. Isolation is mandatory if you have COVID-19 or core COVID-19 symptoms.
