This course is for any and all caregivers concerned about internet safety. The topics covered are safe screen time tips, safety tips for different platforms (YouTube and Google), social media safety tips and terms and conditions (TikTok, Instagram, Snapchat), online gaming safety tips, Discord, live streaming, pornography, sexting, communication, helpful tools, online child sexual exploitation and its forms, online grooming techniques, peer sexual exploitation, signs of online child sexual exploitation, and tips for intervention.

Childcare will be provided to encourage all adult family members to attend. The cost is \$5 per family.
