B.) Hot Lunch / Hot Dog Days

Leah shared that we have had a request to add a "donate" button on our hot lunch ordering program as well as an offer to pay for hot lunches for 3 students for the rest of the school year. The Hot Lunch Committee will work with Colleen to try to facilitate both requests.

D.) Library Project

Colleen presented cost details about the library commons upgrade project during her Westboro School Council Meeting Principal's Report. Please refer to those meeting minutes for more information.

There is approximately \$14,763 in the bank. We have outstanding accounts payable and allocations of about \$5850. There is a Community Initiatives Grant (matching grant) we can apply for to assist with the school library commons upgrade project. Jacque will work with Colleen in the new year to determine funding and grant processes for shelving purchases. Debbie and Jacque will work on a letter to parents for an "adopt a shelf" fundraiser.

E.) Water Bottle Filling Station

As a follow-up to the discussion in September to wait for Infrastructure Maintenance Rehabilitation funding for a school water bottle filling station, Colleen has reviewed current student access to sinks for their use to refill their water bottles. Only one classroom does not have a classroom sink and this class is located right beside the water fountain.

F.) Rick Hansen Accessibility Grant

This program has a grant for up to \$25,000 towards creating accessibility at schools.

Krystal Gibson moves that Jacque works with Colleen to investigate the grant to assist with the proposed sensory garden project, Debbie Klita 2nd. All in favour: "Yes."

G.) Christmas Concert Raffle

Colleen asked our Parents' Group to organize a raffle similar to last year for prime parking spots and seating to help offset the costs of the school Christmas concert. Krystal and Debbie will organize the raffle.

H.) Playground Update
